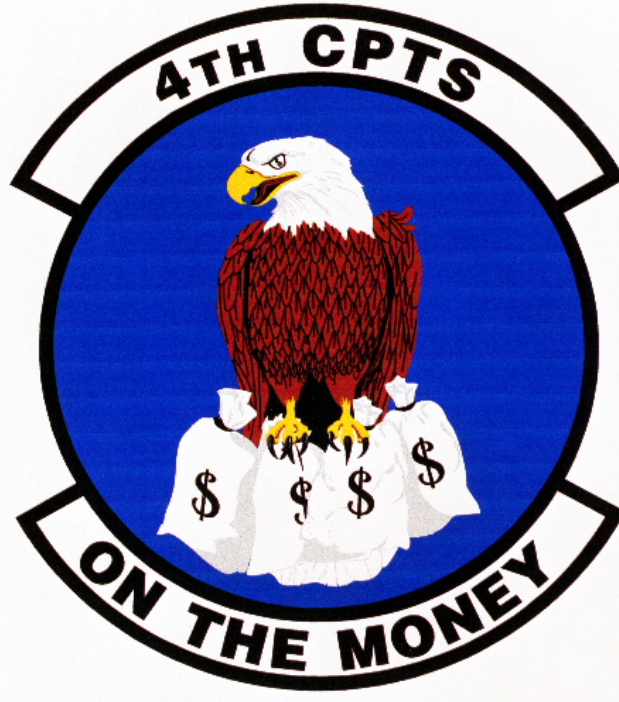

## EMBLEM



Azure, four money bags in base palewise in fess Argent, each charged with the United States dollar sign Sable, supporting a bald eagle close Proper, its pupil a dollar sign Black; all within a diminished bordure of the last. Attached above the disc a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed 4TH CPTS "in Black letters. Attached below the disc a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed ON THE MONEY in Black letters. Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle symbolizes the eagle of the British Royal Air Force and reflects the heritage of the unit's organization. The money bags signify the complete finance support the squadron provides to its home station and deployed locations. (Approved, 4 Apr 1997)
