On a disc Azure, in front of two contrails parallel in bend Argent, each terminating at the wing tips of a flight symbol ascending bendwise in dexter chief Gules, a piece of paper currency fesswise in base Vert, garnished of the second and charged with two dollar signs of the field transfixed by a sword palewise point to base Proper, all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "SERVICE WITH EXCELLENCE" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "14TH COMPTROLLER FLIGHT" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE**: Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force Operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The sword symbolizes resourcefulness, constancy and fortitude. The flight symbol represents courage, patriotism, strength and valor.
