## **OPERATIONS**

One RB-34, a UC-64A and numerous TB-26s were flown by the 15th Tow Target Squadron that was stationed on Shemya.

On June 22, 1944, the 15th Tow Target Squadron Headquarters was transferred from Adak to Shemya with a strength of 27 officers and 160 enlisted men. This organization provided targets for gunnery practice of the air combat units and anti-aircraft batteries based on Shemya.
