Redesignated as Headquarters, 15th Bombardment Wing on 8 May 1929. Headquarters initiated by April 1930 at Boeing Field, Seattle, WA. Redesignated as Headquarters, 15th Transport Wing on 1 October 1933. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 15th Transport Wing on 1 September 1936. Inactivated on 2 March 1937 at Seattle by relief of personnel.
