Headquarters, Far Eastern District, USAF Auditor General —a field extension unit of Hq. USAF, is located in Bldg. 1635, Tachi-West. The Auditor General organization performs an independent and comprehensive audit review and appraisal of all Air Force organizational components within its area of responsibility. The District's Geographical area of responsibility covers all of Japan and points extending to Hawaii, Australia and Pakistan.

Military personnel of the District are assigned to the 1038th USAF Auditor General Squadron which is located with the District Headquarters.

Four separate Auditor General organizations now exist at Tachikawa: Hq. Far Eastern District, USAF Auditor General; 1038th USAF Auditor General Squadron; AMFPA Branch Office, Auditor General; and the Resident Office, Auditor General, The AMFPA Branch Office, also located in Bldg. 1635, has the contract audits responsibility in Japan. The Resident Office is located in Bldg. 757, Tachi-East, and has the internal audits responsibility for Tachikawa Air Base.
