The 1155th Technical Operations Squadron, arrived at McClellan AFB in 1951. The 1155th was a field unit of the 1035th USAF Field Activities Group, Air Force Technical Application Center (AFTAC). Originally designated the Western Field Office of the 1035th USAF Field Activities Group, the 1155th received its present nomenclature on July 1, 1960. The 1155th's mission was to provide worldwide support and deployment of specialized equipment and support personnel to

maintain the McClellan Central Laboratory with its analysis and calibration equipment, aided by complex electronic data processing equipment; and to administer a depot for the repair, modification, and supply of its worldwide organizational network.
