The 1389th AAF Base Unit (Foreign Transport Station) was organized at Kindley Fld under the North Atlantic Division, Air Transport Command (later the Atlantic Division, ATC) on 1 Aug 1944 to replace Station 17, North Atlantic Wing, ATC.

After the war (1 Jan 1946) Bermuda Base Command was transferred to Air Transport Command and it became the 1389th AAF Base Unit (Bermuda Base Command) -- later 1389th AF Base Unit. It remained at Kindley until Jun 1948 when it was replaced by the 522nd Air Base Group.
