MISSION

1401 Air Base Wing mission was housekeeping functions, base support and logistical support for Andrews AFB, all assigned and attached units as well as medical services performed by the 1401st USAF Infirmary. Wing was to provide aircraft and facilities including supervisory, maintenance and administrative, for proficiency and administrative flying by personnel assigned or attached to the base.

Mission also included analyzing operational requirements and planning for effective use of existing facilities. Wing was charged with responsibility for providing adequate base defense program and maintaining state of preparedness. Special missions were indoctrination program for newly commissioned Air Force Reserve officer training corps graduates and providing logistical support to test services unit (Provisional) part of Air Rescue Service.
