On 1 Oct 1987, all equipment and personnel originally assigned to 1867th Facility Checking Squadron at Yokota AB, Japan were reassigned to Detachment 1, 1467th Facility Checking Squadron, which was also designated and activated effective 1 Oct 1987

On 24 Apr 1990, the first of six C-29As arrived to replace the aging C-140s, with the last C-140 departing by 20 August.

On 1 Oct 1991, the 1467th inactivated and its mission and aircraft were transferred to the Federal Aviation Administration's Mike Mulroney Aeronautical Center, Oklahoma City, OK.
