## **EMBLEM**

On a shield argent, on a sphere azure, grid lines of the first, equilateral triangle, point to chief, gules, fimbriated of the first, surmounted by a caduceus in pale of the last. The blue globe on a white shield indicates the group is an organization of Military Air Transport Service. The three points of the red triangle on the globe signify the group's aims are safe, expedient, medically acceptable transportation to patients in the care. The wings with the caduceus superimposed denote the integration of an air transport and medical mission. (Approved, 13 Dec 1955)
