EMBLEM

The emblem represents the integration of the squadron's support into the highest levels of command. The globe and gauntlet are adapted from the emblem of the Air Force Communications Command and indicate the global nature of the parent organization. The computer hardware suggests the unit's function of providing computer support in data processing, executive communications systems, programming, systems software development, and system acquisition. The lightning bolts signify electronic communications systems. Together with the overlapping symbols, they form a triad demonstrating the coordination and intercommunications shared throughout the system.
