EMBLEM

The emblem of the 1876 Communications Group is indicative of the unique mission of the group.

It consists of the symbol of the United States Air Force Academy, the Arctic Gyrfalcon. The falcon is imposed upon the emblem of the Air Force Communications Command (AFCC). It is being supported by the mailed gauntlet representing AFCC's worldwide communications system. The symbology for the remainder of the emblem remains the same as the Air Force Communications Command emblem. The 1876 Communications Group supports the United States Air Force Academy's mission involvement, through the provision of communications-electronics and air traffic control services.
