EMBLEM

The eagle looking down represents the reconnaissance flying mission of Beale Air Force Base. The red lightning bolt symbolizes the communications link and support provided to the flying mission by the squadron. The mountain silhouette is that of the Sutler Buttes, the smallest mountain range in the world. The crossed pick and shovel reflect the gold-mining heritage of the area and of Camp Far West which was located at Beale to protect the miner's and American interest.
