A fairly large and long-standing tenant organization, the 4754th Radar Evaluation Squadron, which arrived at Hill AFB in September 1959, was reassigned from the Aerospace Defense Command (ADC) to the Air Force Communications Service, effective 1 October 1979. In addition, the squadron was renumbered the 1954th. This change resulted from the ADC mission realignments effected on that date. Authorized strength was approximately 213 personnel (37 non-rated officers, 159 airmen, and 17 civilians).

1954th Radar Evaluation Squadron assigned to the Air Force Communications Command was inactivated on 1 October 1987, and simultaneously, the 84th Radar Evaluation Squadron, assigned to the Tactical Air Command, was activated. There were no changes in personnel, equipment or mission.
