EMBLEM

The three white columns, located across the bottom of the disc, represent the squadron's support of the activities symbolized on the emblem. The centrally located starred gear (borrowed from the OC-ALC shield) is symbolic of the Oklahoma City Air Logistic Center and Tinker AFB. The compass (borrowed from the 552d Airborne Warning and Control Wing shield) is symbolic of the 552nd Airborne Warning and Control Wing and the numerous flying missions that the squadron supports. The two lightning bolts (similar to the lightning bolts on the Air Force Communications Command shield) symbolize the electronic nature of the squadron's support and the squadron's relationship to Air Force Communications Command. The circular border symbolizes the continuous nature of the squadron's support.
