In April, 2 ADG had also left, enroute to England to form the nucleus of the Eighth Air Force's maintenance effort. Soon they were supporting strikes against Hitler's "Fortress Europe." With both 2 ADG and 3 ADG deployed, SAD formed the 23rd Air Depot Group in May 1942. The 23 ADG trained replacements as well as conducting combat logistics at McClellan.
