EMBLEM



On a blue disc bordered yellow, a pattern of eight yellow rays shaded orange surmounted by a pair of yellow wings displayed fesswise, overall a yellow Air Force thunderbolt detailed gold brown, entwined by a yellow serpent. Above the thunderbolt in the top of the disc a stylized dove in flight carrying a palm branch in its beak all yellow. Attached below the disc a blank white scroll edged yellow. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron, and the Air Force colors, golden yellow and ultramarine blue are used. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, and yellow to the excellence of Air Force personnel in their assigned duties. The stylized Staff of Caduceus is representative of the Air Force Medical Service, and with the thunderbolt and wings, it represents both the mission of the Squadron to provide administrative and professional medical service, and recognition that it is an Air Force unit. The rays refer to world-wide capability. The dove with palm branch is symbolic of the peaceful and humanitarian good the Medical Services bestow. (Approved, 13 Sep 1967)
