Constituted in the Regular Army on 6 February 1923 as Headquarters, 25th Balloon Group and assigned to the Panama Canal Department. Designated Active Associate was the 6th Composite Group. Designated mobilization training station was France Field, CZ, 1923-27. Demobilized on 28 February 1927. Reconstituted 18 October 1927 and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Fort Sam Houston, TX, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area 1 September 1928 and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Organized by June 1929 with Organized Reserve personnel as a RAI unit at Chicago, IL. Designated mobilization training station was Scott Field, IL, 1927-33.
