### **EMBLEM**



On a disc Sable, a gauntlet issuant from dexter base Argent (Silver Gray) detailed of the field supporting a globe enhanced Or axis bendwise gridlined of the first charged with four piles in point reversed bendwise sinister terminating in a flight symbol delta ascending to sinister Azure, all within a narrow border Green. Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Green border and inscribed "WE FUND THE FIGHT" in Green letters. Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Green border and inscribed "28TH COMPTROLLER SQ" in Green letters. **SIGNIFICANCE**: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe and aircraft symbol describe the acquisition career field, the gauntlet indicates the traditions of the parent unit.
