functions in the entire Pacific area. They were to perform standby service for movement of special weapons by AF aircraft operating in the Pacific and clear ranges, when required to do so.

The 2703 EODS made work assignments and technically assisted its detachments. Besides providing assistance its job was to plan and accomplish proficiency training of all squadron personnel.

AFLC relieved the 2703rd Explosive Ordnance Disposal Squadron and its Detachments from assignment to OOAMA (2705th Air Munitions Wing) and assigned it to the Pacific Air Forces 1 Apr 1962
