#### **OPERATIONS**

In 1959, when GEEIA accepted responsibility for training ANG squadrons, the 2866th became the advisory unit to five ANG GEEIA units: the 214th in Louisiana, the 272nd and 273rd in Texas, and the 205th and 219th Oklahoma. In July 1964, the USAF dissolved the Mobile Depot Activity (MDA) and GEEIA assumed the additional tasking of on-site maintenance of communications electronics equipment.

On 1 May 1970, the 2866th GEEIA was redesignated the 1827th Electronics Installation (EIS) when AFCS merged with GEEIA.
