AMC designated and organized the 2870th GEEIA Squadron, assigned to the Ogden GEEIA Region.  
1 JAN 1959

Further development of the GEEIA organization came on 1 January 1959 when an old tenant at Hill AFB, the 7th Communications Construction Squadron, was inactivated. Concurrently, AMC designated and organized the 2870th GEEIA Squadron, assigned to the Ogden GEEIA Region.

A reorganization within the GEEIA brought reassignment of the 2870th GEEIA Squadron from the Ogden GEEIA Region to the Western GEEIA Region, McClellan AFB, California on 1 July 1959.

AMC reassigned the 2870th GEEIA Squadron, Hill AFB from the Ogden GEEIA Region to the Western GEEIA Region, McClellan AFB, California and organized Detachment 2, Headquarters, Western GEEIA Region at Hill AFB. 15 Nov 1958

On this date, the 2870 GEEIA Squadron was reassigned from the Air Force Logistics Command to the Air Force Communications Service. Involved in the transfer were: eight officers, 73 airmen and 10 civilians. 1 Apr 1970

The 2870 GEEIA Squadron was redesignated the 1832 Electronics Installation Squadron and was assigned to the Northern Communications Area, of the Air Force Communications Service., 1 May 1970 The 1832 Electronics Installation Squadron at Hill AFB was inactivated. At the time of
