OPERATIONS

On December 1, 1967, Headquarters AFLC activated new units at each of its five air materiel areas; San Antonio Air Materiel Area's was the 2954th Combat Logistical Support Squadron. By 1971, the Kelly-based squadron had served at Tan Son Nhut and Bien Hoa Air Bases in South Vietnam and U-Tapao Air Base in Thailand, performing time compliance technical order work on B-52s and providing supply support. During Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm in 1990 and 1991, men and women of the 2954th deployed again - this time to Southwest Asia where they repaired battle-damaged B-52s, set up bare-base air freight terminals, and overhauled jet engines.

By 1971, the Kelly-based squadron had served at Tan Son Nhut and Bien Hoa Air Bases in South Vietnam and U-Tapao Air Base in Thailand, performing time compliance technical order work on B-52s and providing supply support. During Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm in 1990 and 1991, men and women of the 2954th deployed again - this time to Southwest Asia where they repaired battle-damaged B-52s, set up bare-base air freight terminals, and overhauled jet engines.

Squadron members restored and returned to active service a mothballed T-38 and assisted in the restoration of a B-29 and F-100. 1985/1986

Squadron hosted Port Call, a worldwide Department of Defense exercise.
