OPERATIONS

In 1968, the 2955th Combat Logistics Support Squadron (CLSS) was formed in conjunction with the Rapid Area Maintenance (RAM) and Rapid Area Supply Support (RASS) Teams. Its military teams were deployed to provide depot repair and modification work in the field. Since then, the 2955th CLSS has increased the scope of its mission to provide rapid aircraft battle damage repair and combat packaging and supply operations. The Transportation and Maintenance Branches Of the 2955th CLSS deploy combat distribution teams, rapid aircraft battle damage augmentation repair teams, combat aircraft repair teams and rapid air maintenance teams to handle work in the field.

These 2955th CLSS military teams Often work with civilian maintenance technicians at the depot while on temporary duty or on the flight-line on the F-15 at Robins. Occasionally, they will be accompanied on TOY trips by civilian maintenance workers. This is but another example of the military-civilian teamwork which has become a trademark lor the Warner Robins Air Logistics Center.

The Transportation and Maintenance Branches of the 2955th CLSS deploy combat distribution teams, rapid aircraft battle damage augmentation repair teams, combat aircraft repair teams and rapid air maintenance teams to handle work in the field. These 2955th CLSS military teams often work with civilian maintenance technicians at the depot while on temporary duty or on the flightline on the F-15 at Robins. Occasionally, they will be accompanied on temporary duty trips by civilian maintenance workers.

Members of the 2955th Combat Logistics Support Squadron completed major temporary structural repairs to permit a severely crash-damaged C-130 to fly again. The aircraft crash-landed in The Azores in 1984. The 2955th joined the nose of a C-130 that crashed in West Germany to

the Azores-damaged aircraft, and the plane was flown to a depot maintenance facility in Italy. 21 May 1986
Squadron members deployed to Bogota, Columbia for a C-130 recovery project. 1990/1991
