OPERATIONS

On 30 March 1951, the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron moved from its duty-training station at Kelly AFB, Texas, coming via Hill AFB to the Army's Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah on 1 April 1951. Administratively the Squadron was a part of the 25th Supply Group of the 25th Air Depot Wing at Hill AFB.

APR 1951 The 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron moved from Kelly AFB, Texas to Hill AFB and on to Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah. It was attached to the 25th Supply Group of the 25th Air Depot Wing at Hill AFB for administrative purposes.

1 Apr 1951 The 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron arrived at Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah to begin performance of similar ammunition functions as the 25th. Assigned to OOAMA, it received logistical support from the Army's 6th Army outfit at Tooele. It was a part of the 25th Supply Group of Ogden's 25th Air Depot Wing which furnished administrative and operational control.

1 APR 1951 The 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron moved from Kelly AFB, Texas to Hill AFB and on to Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah. It was attached to the 25th Supply Group of the 25th Air Depot Wing at Hill AFB for administrative purposes.

AMC redesignated the 25th, 29th and 30th Ammunition Supply Squadrons as Supply Squadrons (Depot). 1 NOV 1954

8 May 1955 AMC inactivated the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron, transferring 17 of its 44 personnel to overseas ammunition outfits and the remainder to the 25th and 29th Ammunition Supply Squadrons.

AMC inactivated the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron (Depot), reassigning 17 of its 44 personnel to overseas outfits, and the remainder to the 25th and 29th Ammunition Supply Squadrons. 8 MAY 1955

Now AMC brought its ammunition outfits to Hill AFB. On 1 August 1955 it moved the 2949th Support Group, with its 25th and 29th Ammunition Supply Squadrons, stationed at the Army's Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah, to Hill. The 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron was a part of the 2949th until 8 May 1955 when AMC activated it, transferred 17 of its 44 personnel to overseas ammunition organizations and the remainder to bolster the 25th and 29th Ammunition Supply Squadrons.

AMC reactivated and reconstituted the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron (inactivated 8 May 1955), assigning it to the 2949th Support Group at Hill AFB. On 20 August 1956 the Squadron moved to an overseas base in the United States Air Forces in Europe. 1 JAN 1956

8 Jan 1956 AMC reactivated and reconstituted the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron under the 2949th Support Group. Seven months later, 20 August 1956, AMC moved it to a duty station in United States Air Forces in Europe.

The 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron moved from Kelly AFB, Texas to Hill AFB and on to Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah. It was attached to the 25th Supply Group of the 25th Air Depot Wing at Hill AFB for administrative purposes., 1 Apr 1951

AMC inactivated the 25th Air Depot Wing and concurrently organized to take its place the 2949th Depot Training Wing which included the 2949th Supply Group, Depot. The 25th and 30th Ammunition Supply Squadrons became a part of the training wing with duty station at Tooele Ordnance Depot, Tooele, Utah., 12 Oct 1951

AMC redesignated the 25th, 29th and 30th Ammunition Supply Squadrons as Supply Squadrons (Depot). 8 Nov 1954

AMC inactivated the 30th Ammunition Supply Squadron (Depot), reassigning 17 of its 44 personnel to overseas outfits, and the remainder to the 25th and 29th Ammunition Supply Squadrons. 8 May 1955
