Constituted in the Regular Army on 1 October 1933 as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 32nd Pursuit Group, assigned to the 5th Attack Wing, and allotted to the Fourth Corps Area. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 32nd Observation Group on 1 January 1938 and assigned to the Third Army. Organized by December 1938 with Organized Reserve personnel as a RAI unit at Atlanta, GA. Designated mobilization training station was Pope Field, NC.
