Constituted in the Regular Army on 1 October 1933 as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 33rd Pursuit Group, assigned to the 5th Attack Wing, and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Designated mobilization training station was San Angelo, TX. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 33rd Observation Group on 1 January 1938. Organized by July 1938 with Organized Reserve personnel as a RAI unit at Chicago, IL.
