MISSION

The 42nd Supply squadron provided direct support to over 20 organizations and played a vital role in ensuring that the 42nd Bombardment Wing accomplished its missions.

One of the largest squadrons on base, the 42nd Supply Squadron had personnel authorizations of 283, including 241 military and 42 civilians. Its real estate consisted of 23 building and approximately 250,000 square feet of open and closed warehouse space. Major supply functions and squadron administration offices are located in Bldg 7220.
