

## 49 MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS SQUADRON



### MISSION

49 Maintenance Operations Squadron ensures key elements are available to support the wing flying mission. Responsible for maintenance coordination, command and control, plans and scheduling, and analysis. Manages 49 Fighter Wing operation training and contingency taskings for 2,400 personnel. Provides engine management for four types of engines for 85 aircraft; tracks all logistics assets to/from depot. Manages quality assurance, manpower, facility, computer and awards programs for the squadron and the group.
