AMC designated and organized the 3082nd Aviation Depot Sq, Fairchild AFB, Spokane, Wash., 4 April 1952, giving Ogden general court-martial jurisdiction and separation action responsibility. On 10 April 1952 AMC reopened the Spokane Air Depot, Fairchild AFB, Wash. AMC discontinued the USAF Storage Branch at Spokane on 10 April 1952. Concurrently the location of the 2756th Supply Squadron, assigned to Ogden, changed from Fairchild AFB, Spokane, Wash., to Spokane Air Depot, Fairchild AFB, Wash. On 21 April 1952 AMC discontinued the 2756th Supply Squadron and in its place established HQ, 2834th Air Depot Group, assigned to the Spokane Air Depot, which AMC discontinued on 1 November 1953. On 1 May 1952 AMC relieved Ogden of jurisdiction for the Spokane Air Depot, that began functioning as a separate AMC activity without change of station or personnel.
