The 3215th Drone Squadron from Eglin's Air Proving Ground Center provided the target drones for the BOMARC IM-99A test program. On 5 December 1958, the Squadron was discontinued, but it was succeeded by the 3205th Drone Group, Detachment # 1, which continued flying drone targets

for BOMARC tests well into 1959. Once the 1M-99A portion of the program was completed, drones were no longer required. Detachment #1 departed for Eglin on 8 June 1959.
