OPERATIONS

Contract Primary Bases Closed. While training at the contract schools ended in December 1960, Air Training Command did not stop operation of the training units until early 1961. Effective 16 January, ATC discontinued the 3306th Pilot Training Group at Bainbridge, and on 1 February the other four groups the 3300th at Graham, the 3301st at Moore, the 3302d at Spence, and the 3303d at Bartow ceased to exist. The command had intended to shut all five bases by March, but

an Air Force-imposed freeze on shipping property delayed closure. Finally, ATC released control of Bainbridge and Spence on 31 March, Bartow on 19 May, and Graham on 31 August. Moore Air Base remained on inactive status until 15 July 1963, when part of the installation was sold to private concerns and the rest transferred to the Department of Agriculture.
