The command established the squadron to look after ATC's interest in the acquisition of the T-46A. The squadron fell under the administrative and operational control of the Acquisition Directorate in DCS/Plans, with the director dual-hatted as the squadron commander. To carry out its unique mission, the 3307th had a detachment at Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, to interface with the Air Force Systems Command T-46 Systems Program Office and an operating location at the prime contractor's (Fairchild Republic) facility in Farmingdale, New York.
