26 Aug 1948 The 3310th Technical Training Wing (TTW) was established and took over management of Scott AFB from the 3505th Army Air Forces Base Unit. Under the 3310 TTW were four groups; 3310th Air Base Group, 3310th Technical Training Group, 3310th Maintenance and Supply Group, and 3310th Station Hospital.

1 July — 30 September 1948 The reorganization of the 3505th AF Base Unit to the 3310th Technical Training Wing and subordinate Table of Distribution Units, effective 26 August 1948 was accomplished without excessive difficulty despite the administrative load involved. Gen. Kiel became commander of the Wing as well as of Scott Air Force Base 26 Aug. 1948. Directly under

the Wing Commander are the Executive Officer, Public Information Officer, Inspector General, Air Inspector, Air Provost Marshal and the Hq. and Hq. Sq., consisting of the wing staff and the personnel.

1 Oct 1957 Military Air Transport Service (MATS) officially assumed jurisdiction over Scott AFB. The 3310th Technical Training Wing (minus the school units) was redesignated as the 1405th Air Base Wing.
