Greenville AFB Inactivated. In December 1963 Secretary of Defense Robert McNamara announced that Greenville AFB would close in 1965. During the first half of 1964, ATC began moving medical training from Greenville to Gunter AFS in Alabama. Personnel courses transferred to Amarillo, and firefighting went to Chanute. On 1 April 1965, ATC inactivated Greenville and its 3505th Technical Training Group. At the same time, ATC assigned the base to Keesler in caretaker status, until it returned to civilian control on 27 October 1966.
