The command brought Laughlin back on active status on 1 May. At the same time ATC established the 3645th Pilot Training Wing (Basic ,Single-Engine) and assigned it to Flying Training Air Force. Then

on 1 October the 3645th was redesignated as a flying training wing (fighter) and reassigned to Crew Training Air Force.
Effective 16 October 1961, ATC designated and organized the 3645th Pilot Training Wing at Laughlin AFB, Texas. The purpose of the activation was so that ATC could transfer half of its training mission from Laredo (where facilities were substandard) to Laughlin.
