Lt. Colonel John A. Dillon, Jr. headed the 377th Medical Group and the Sidi Slimane Air Base Hospital. Colonel Dillon had brought the Medical Group to French Morocco in September, 1951, and set up the Base Hospital. Still a "bare bones" facility, much progress had been made and soon a complete hospital facility would be constructed.

Other changes were mainly in name and number, such as redesignating the 377th USAF Hospital at Sidi Slimane Air Base the 3906th USAF Hospital, a number in keeping with the base

3906<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Group designation.

Colonel John T. Heavey commanded the 3906th USAF Hospital at Sidi Slimane Air Base in 1958.
