OPERATIONS

The 4453rd Combat Training Wing operated as the main F-4C training unit at Davis-Monthan AFB, Arizona, after moving from MacDill AFB, Florida, where both F-4Bs and F-4Cs were operated. It incorporated the 4454th CCTS, 4455th CCTS and 4456th CCTS .

The F-4 operations were reassigned to the 58th TFTW at Luke AFB, Arizona, the switch bringing A-7D Corsairs to Davis-Monthan AFB. The 4453rd CCTW's F-4Cs were used to form the 310th TFTS, 426th TFTS and 550th TFTS at Luke AFB, forming the 355th TFW (with the same personnel), which activated on 1 July 1971. The 4453rd CCTW formally inactivated on 30 September 1971.
