

60th TRANSPORT SQUADRON

Four other squadrons were assigned briefly to Patterson Field as the Air Corps began expanding for World War II. The 11th Transport Squadron, assigned to the 60th Transport Group, was activated December 1, 1940 at Patterson Field; the 13th Transport Squadron, assigned to the 61st Transport Group, was activated December 1, 1941 at Patterson; the 19th Bombardment Squadron (Medium), assigned to the 2nd Bombardment Group (Medium) at Mitchel Field, New York, was activated February 1, 1940 at Patterson; and the 33rd Bombardment Squadron (Medium), assigned to the 22nd Bombardment Group (Medium), was also activated February 1, 1940 at Patterson. The 19th and the 33rd Bombardment Squadrons both flew Douglas B-18 medium bombers.
