The primary mission constituted patrol of the Chesapeake Bay and significant portions of the Atlantic seaboard to search for and attack enemy shipping and submarines.25 The B-17s patrolled to a distance of approximately 600 miles, the B-18s and B-25s conducted short range missions. The squadrons maintained a log and photographs of all shipping sighted. A secondary mission during the first year

was assisting the Navy in protecting of allied merchant shipping. By July 1942 patrol planes began using the British-developed air-surface vessel (ASV) radar in connection with the American-developed magnetic anomaly detector (MAD). Both were used together since the former was best for detecting surface vessels at long distances, while the latter, though of shorter range, could
