OPERATIONS

The Air Police Squadron at Tan Son Nhut came into being as the 6250th Air Police Squadron on 1 October 1965. Prior to that time it was a section within the Support Squadron. When activated, the squadron strength was less than 200 personnel. With the massive buildup in Southeast Asia, the squadron grew rapidly in November and December 1965, more than doubling in size. By March 1966, the squadron reached its authorized strength. On 8 April 1966, the squadron inactivated and replaced by the 377th Air Police Squadron.
