Per bend or and azure, a Test Track bendwise throughout argent and sable between an arrow palewise couped, point to chief gules enveloped by an orbital ring fesswise terminating into an arrowhead all sable, and a radar antenna gules, overall in pale a missile ascending silver, fimbriated of the second, emitting twin flames to base of the first, all within a diminished bordure of the last. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The missile is symbolic of the Group's role in missile development. The vertical arrow represents the Central Inertial Guidance Test Facility and the radar antenna represents RAT SCAT. The diagonal white and black stripe represents the Test Track. (Approved, 12 May 1971).

The ultramarine blue is indicative of the unknown facing all research and development . The golden yellow is symbolic of the knowledge gained. The vermilion vertical arrow represents the Central Inertial Guidance Test Facility. The radar antenna represents RAT SCAT. The diagonal white and black stripe represents the Test Track. Finally, the silver missile is symbolic of the 6585th Test Group's role in missile development.
