TUSLOG (Turkish-U.S. Logistics) Detachment 3-1. Although fully operating Squadrons and Groups, USAFSS units operating in Turkey were officially referred to as TUSLOG (Turkish/U.S. Logistics) Detachments as cover names due to an agreement with the Turkish government.

In the late 1960's, demands on the U.S. defense budget and manpower by the Viet forced a reconsideration of military priorities in other parts of the world.
