OPERATIONS

The 7132d Support Group was activated on 7 September to prepare the base until the new tenant's advance detachment arrived to assume command responsibility for base preparation. After three years of idleness there was some deterioration of the building interiors, runway, and vehicle fleet.

Support personnel initiated large base restoration programs including sealing the joints of all taxiways, marguerites, and the runway.

Building interiors were examined, and heating, plumbing, electrical, and fire protection defects were logged and repaired if parts were available.

USAFE had established base maintenance contracts with French companies to maintain the standby bases. Compagnie Generale de Chauffe performed day-to-day facility maintenance, freeing the Civil Engineer shops to support new construction and design new project plans for bidding.
