## **OPERATIONS**

Following the activation of the 7207th in 1955, the Air Force made improvements to the airfield by constructing a weather observation site, replacing revetments, installing special lighting,

resurfacing the runway, and paving the overruns. The 7207th had two C-47s assigned for liaison duty.

15 February 1955, USAFE designated and activated "Aviano Airfield #1" to support NATOcommitted rotational units from Tactical Air Command. The next day. 16 February 1955, the 7207th Air Base Squadron moved from Giebelstadt AB, Federal Republic of Germany, to Aviano Airfield #1. The 7207th, consisting of personnel from Detachment 1, Seventeenth Air Force (located at Udine) and some personnel from the 629 ACWS, served as the base's first USAF host unit.
