With The Assignment Of A Rotational C-130 Tactical Air Command (Tac) Unit When 778 Tactical Airlift Squadron From Pope Air Force Base Nc Arrived For Three Month Temporary Duty.

7310th Tactical Airlift Wing. The command added a second tactical airlift wing to its inventory on 1 November. Headquarters USAFE redesignated the 7310th Air Base Group at Rhein Main Air Base as the 7310th Tactical Airlift Wing and assigned the unit to Seventeenth Air Force. 1968

Tactical Airlift Wing Changes. At Rhein Main Air Base, Germany, USAFE inactivated the 7310th Tactical Airlift Wing on 1 January and activated the 322d Tactical Airlift Wing, using personnel and supplies from the 7310th.
