### **EMBLEM**

On a disc Azure, issuant in base in saltire two flight paths, one arcing to dexter, the other arcing to sinister Gules, each charged with a delta, point up, at its midpoint Silver Gray, overall a winged caduceus Or detailed Gold Brown, bearing an escutcheon in chief Argent, charged with a cross of the second, all within a narrow border Blue. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "82D AEROSPACE MEDICINE SQ" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The medical caduceus with a white medical shield and red cross is a traditional insignia of the men and women in the field of medicine. The aircraft and their flight path signify the strength, might and capabilities of the Airmen and the United States Air Force providing air and space superiority as they circumnavigate the globe.
