Constituted in the Organized Reserve 24 June 1921, assigned to the 84th Division, and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Headquarters initiated in December 1921 at Cleveland, OH. Inactivated on 11 August 1922 at Cleveland. Reorganized on 13 November 1922 at Schoen Field, Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN. Redesignated as Headquarters, 84th Division Aviation on 10 March 1928. Demobilized on 15 February 1929.
