EMBLEM

On a disc Vert, a bald eagle volant reversed Proper, grasping in its talons a scroll open Argent, scripted Sable, below a flight symbol bendwise point to chief Azure flaunches of the second, all within a double border White within Blue. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a

narrow Blue border and inscribed "89TH CONTRACTING SQ" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "LEADING THE WAY" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The green background signifies the large amount of money the unit handles. The eagle represents the exceptional personnel designated to serve the contracting corps with strength, unity and leadership. The parchment embodies the attention to detail placed on contracts, money and support. The air symbol denotes the Air Force mission and aerospace power.
