EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, above a wreath Vert charged with five mullets Or, a cross-couped Gules, surmounted by a winged Staff of Aesculapius of the third, serpent and details Sable, all within a diminished bordure Yellow. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow

border and inscribed "96TH MEDICAL SUPPORT SQ" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "SUPPORTING EXCELLENCE" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The Staff of Aesculapius surmounting the red cross symbolizes the Air Force Medical Services and represents the 96th Medical Group's mission as the main objective. The wreath and five stars encompass the medical symbols demonstrating the teamwork in support of the Group mission. The stars placed on the wreath represent the five units composing the Group. The star in the center of the wreath denotes the supportive role of the Squadron and the foundation they provide in support of their sister squadrons.
